

LTTC Language Tests

In order to provide test references for government agencies, educational institutions, and individual language learners who use Taiwan's language proficiency tests, the Taiwan Ministry of Education (MOE) adopted the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) in 2005 and required major local tests to be mapped onto the CEFR.

The tables below show the score range/level of the tests developed by the LTTC and their corresponding CEFR levels.
