The song "Hello Vietnam" was written by Tom T. Hall, an American songwriter in 1965 as part of his support for the Vietnam War.

In an increasingly high-rise world, where shopping malls, skyscrapers, and high-rise apartments are eclipsing old French colonial buildings, the size of life in the city-- Saigon, also presently known as Ho Chi Minh City is redefining itself.

The Fall of Saigon

What comes to mind when you think of war? Power struggles, war baptism, colonization, independence, openness and cultural influence...In 1885, due to the Treaty of Tientsin, the Nguyễn Dynasty was overthrown. Vietnam developed into a century-long colony. The French Indochina was established. Then the outbreak of World War II, France fell under German control. Japan then took control of Vietnam. With the surrender of Imperial Japan in 1945, World War II came to an end. Again, France returned to Vietnam. With the Geneva Accords, the year 1954 changed everything. Vietnam was involved in a protracted struggle with two forms of government. North Vietnam was dominated by the Soviet Union while South Vietnam focused mainly on the United States, thus making Vietnam a phenomenon of the North and South divide, the communist government of North Vietnam and the US-backed government of South Vietnam.

The year 1975 was a milestone. The American soldiers ultimately retreated from the battlefields and the communists seized control of South Vietnam, bringing about the end of the war. A year later, the unification of the south and north was declared by the Socialist Republic of Vietnam. Saigon fell to North Vietnam. Now it is the largest and the most prosperous commercial hub in Vietnam. With influences from both western and oriental cultures, Saigon features exotic scenes.

Religions in Vietnam

The country experienced a period of the colonial era during the French Empire. It might not be difficult to fully comprehend the harmony that exists between Western and oriental cultures. Prior to the period of the French colony, Buddhism was the predominant religion in Vietnam; however, after the French colonial rule, Catholicism eventually overtook Buddhism as the dominant religion.

Mixtures of Architectures

Ancient Saigon buildings with a facade of French colonial shophouses flourish commercial businesses. Generally speaking, a shophouse, also called a colored compartment, refers to a building consisting of a store opening on the ground floor of sidewalks and the owner also lives on the upper floor of the premises. Furthermore, one of the most impressive architectural masterpieces in Saigon is the Notre Dame Cathedral, a structure influenced by French styles. The construction began in 1863, followed by the addition of two church spires three decades later. Apart from visiting the Notre Dame Cathedral in Saigon, the People's Committee Head Office in Ho Chi Minh City and the City Opera House are also wonderful French-style buildings of Vietnamese heritage that offer visitors a glance at a taste of Vietnamese history. Consequently, Saigon exhibits a strong French influence in its architecture.

A Sea of Nón Lá

At dawn, morning calls with a sea of Nón Lá, also known as conical bamboo hats, activate morning markets. You can find a variety of traditional symbols of Vietnam in morning markets, which include bamboo hats, fermented fish sauce, and bánh mì (Vietnamese cuisine).

By tracing the scent of fermented fish sauce, you might enjoy the taste from a drop of morning freshness. Another typical example of their exotic food is bánh mì. In the mid-19th century, the French introduced baguettes, literally called bánh mì, to Vietnam. All kinds of fresh ingredients and Vietnamese delicacies can be purchased at local bustling markets. What's more, the fish in colanders is fresh and still wriggling. Brightly-colored swimming crabs and pearly clams are waving hello to you. How delightful!

A brand new future

Over the past few decades, Vietnam has been regarded as a microcosm of world war history with countless bombs dropped on its soil, roaring fighter jets circling above its head, and a nearly century-long colonial past. Now, Vietnam is growing its own civilization by nourishing itself with its glorious past and moving in the direction of sustainable development for a brand new future.


