Have you ever encountered some gray, green and yellow boxes on your Twitter or Facebook feeds? Perhaps the answer is Y-E-S! Meet Wordle, one of the most sought-after puzzle games that has taken the world by storm. Interestingly, the game was originally designed by Josh Wardle, a software engineer, for his puzzle-loving girlfriend. He even playfully named it after his last name, Wardle. Little did he know that this sweet little act between lovers would be all the rage within a short period. During its launch in November, 2021, only ninety people played it. Yet there was a sudden and meteoric rise, up to millions of players within four months. So, what is Wordle and what is the appeal of this game?

Wordle is a web-based word game that features a new five-letter puzzle every day. Players are allowed to solve the puzzle once per day within 6 attempts. To start, players enter a real random word. Each letter will turn green, yellow, or gray. Green boxes mean the correct letters in the right spaces. Yellow ones indicate they are in the word but the wrong spots. Gray ones mean they are not parts of the answer. Here are several witty strategies for the starting word, which is used for the first attempt. Since most words tend to have common letters and vowels, guessing words with non-repeated high-frequency consonants (r, t, n, s) or multiple vowels helps. Try A-R-I-S-E instead of P-I-Z-Z-A next time, and maybe they'll help you become a C-H-A-M-P.

So how did this daily challenge evolve from a plain word game to what is now a phenomenon? The answer is simplicity, shareability, and scarcity. Compared to other paid apps, Wordle is a free web-based game that requires no membership and pricing plans. More importantly, they can share their results with color-coded grids, only that the letters are gone. It gives the players' followers a sense of progress every day without spoiling the puzzle. Once the players fail after six attempts, they have to wait fretfully until tomorrow—as there is only one word a day. When most other games are created to get players addicted, Wordle leaves its players wanting more.

In addition to the appeal of its game design, Wordle also plays a critical role during the COVID-19 pandemic. When people are bombarded by depressing news, Wordle fosters an online community and provides a great conversation starter for people. During this era of isolation, remote jobs, and social distancing, the challenging and compelling "competition" is a lovely distraction. It seems to be telling people that even when the world is falling into pieces, there is still something small and definite that can soothe their pandemic blue. Happy puzzling!


