
### MESSAGE







Host	Today, in our program, we have four guests to talk about the reparability scores.			
Peter	Here's my own experience, I bought a vacuum with a 9.5 reparability score, and I successfully fixed it on my own. It saved time and money because I didn't need to send it back to its manufacturer.			
Linda	Do you guys know that the reparability scores are scored by the companies themselves? So, is the score really trustworthy? I don't think so. Also, a high reparability score doesn't mean high quality.
