 <p>Smith (student)</p>	<p>I believe ChatGPT is a useful tool for improving language skills like reading and writing. For example, if you want to make sure you did not make mistakes in your writings, you can enter your sentences into ChatGPT and ask it to correct errors. To make sure my report is perfect, I did so last night, and it really helped me find out my grammar mistakes. I enjoyed having a conversation with the chatbot. It makes language learning an interesting thing.</p>	
 <p>Mr. Yang (professor)</p>	<p>AI makes cheating in exams and homework easier. Some people think it is a good tool, but I have to warn my students the limitation of AI like ChatGPT. They have to know that _____(1)_____, so they have to be careful. If I find my students using ChatGPT to do their homework, they will fail the class for sure. No AI is allowed in my class!</p>	
 <p>Mina (student)</p>	<p>ChatGPT and Bard are both chatbots that can give a human-like response to users when they key in a <u>prompt</u>. For example, when I wrote something like “Tell me three ways to learn English,” it listed three ways “Environment,” “Course,” and “Language partner.” Although ChatGPT and Bard are similar, they still have</p>	

		<p>some differences. ChatGPT's data sources ended in 2021, so it is more limited; Bard, however, search the web in real time to find the latest information. Bard seems to be useful but it is still under testing. I am glad that I live in the world with AI. They bring convenience to my life.</p>
	 <p>Mrs. Lee (professor)</p>	<p>I allow my students to use ChatGPT as a study tool. Instead of stopping students from using AI, I believe it is more important to teach them how to use such those tools to support learning. With the help of AI, students can get information they need and make things done more easily.</p>
